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### Meeting Minutes and Agenda:

Diana Helander called the June 22, 2009 meeting to order at 2:05 p.m. Eastern. The roll call of the meeting participants is reflected above. The agenda for the June 22, 2009 meeting was approved as presented (Odden/Jahn) The meeting minutes for the June 8, 2009 meeting were approved as presented. (Kohn/Odden)

### Announcements:

Diana Helander announced that Adobe Systems received a request from a journalist who was writing an article on PDF Healthcare. Adobe Public Relations will respond to the journalist. It is likely that the committee may be asked to share their views to be incorporated in the article.

### Old Business:

- Technical Subcommittee Discussion – Anatole Matveief/Steve Waldren

Steve and Anatole reported that the Technical Subcommittee is continuing to work on an update of the CDA work. The subcommittee had hoped to receive an update from David McCallie but that was not received.

Rob Warfel is continuing on the CDA work and drafting a white paper that explains this effort. A preliminary release of the draft was shared with Lenora (HL7) who reviewed the draft and provided comments for the subcommittee to consider. The subcommittee reviewed the comments and provided a response to Lenora along with a revised draft. The comments received were based upon the white paper outline.

Unique Identifiers are being used on the form that is being developed. The subcommittee will be modifying the Unique Identifiers after the form is finalized. The Unique Identifiers may modify the workflow.

- Marketing Subcommittee Discussion – Deborah Kohn

Deborah Kohn reported that the Marketing Subcommittee did not meet last week.

Dr. Waldren's audio PowerPoint tutorial was posted on the MrHISTalk blog and received 250 views which is great. Deborah thanked Dr. Waldren for creating this presentation.

Michael Jahn promoted the tutorial with as many individuals as possible through his Twitter account and various blogs. Michael has some HL7 individuals following him. The Marketing Subcommittee requested that AIIM post a link to the tutorial on the AIIM web site.

Deborah Kohn contacted David McCallie and Jamie Ferguson to discuss PDF Healthcare and attempt to reach government. Only Jamie provided a response to Deborah.

The committee discussed ways of promoting the white paper when the Technical Subcommittee has completed the work on it.

The committee discussed the PDF Healthcare Microsite and would like it to be similar to the Health2.0 web site. AIIM was requested to provide a prototype for the committee to review.

Deborah Kohn announced that the article she wrote earlier in the year was published in the July/August issue of

Infonomics, AIIM's magazine and in the July issue of Advance for Healthcare Information Executives which is a digital publication.

New Business

- John Odden discussed his outreach to CalRHIO and Kaiser. John has not received a formal response from Kaiser as the use of PDF Healthcare. Kaiser is charging patients who request their healthcare records in electronic format a \$5 fee for a thumb drive to put their records on. CalRHIO will not exchange information in PDF Healthcare format with their patients. CalRHIO considers PDF Healthcare to be still in the development stage rather than completed as it is. Deborah Kohn stated that Kaiser is using PDF but questioned if they are using PDF Healthcare. MinuteClinic is using some of the features and functions of PDF Healthcare but not the full Best Practices Guide.
- John Odden is considering posting a health information exchange map showing how PDF Healthcare fits into the information exchange cycle.
- Michael Jahn shared a draft form that could be used as a prototype demonstration. The document is not connected to a database but is a powerful use case. The form will be shared with the Technical Subcommittee for evaluation and modification to ensure that it conforms to the Best Practices Guide.
- The committee agreed that Dr. Waldren's presentation supports PDF Healthcare and that Deborah Kohn's article provides the testimonial for PDF Healthcare.
