

**iECM Conference Call**  
**Special Meeting**  
**Meeting Notes**  
**August 26, 2008**

This August 26, 2008 conference call for the iECM is a special meeting convened to discuss the potential for iECM to take on the task of working on the revision of the ANSI/AIIM/ARMA TR48 as an International Technical Report.

Charles Dollar initiated the discussion by requesting that the iECM committee review ANSI/AIIM/ARMA TR48 and identify any areas of conflict with Enterprise Content Management (ECM). It was also requested that if there were areas identified that needed to be improved or that were very good, they should also be noted.

It was noted that document management and records management were viewed as sub-categories of ECM. Those on the call noted that a model for ECM was something that was needed and should be considered to be a part of the iECM work that could also be used in other works.

The members on the call noted that there is a commonality of the projects (iECM work and TR48). The TR48 document needs to be evaluated in context of the work being performed.

Tim Sprehe noted that the C30 committee that originated this work was disbanded and that the iECM would need to take the work on if it was decided that the work should move forward.

TR48's intent was to describe the integration of two content management tools. However, the world has moved beyond these tools and is more than sharing content.

On behalf of the iECM, those on the call recommended that the project to internationalize the ANSI/AIIM/ARMA TR48 not move forward.
