Signs Your Organization Might Need **RIM** in **AI Governance**



Your AI system is making decisions, but no one can explain how the data was created.



The organization has an AI governance committee—but no one manages records retention for AI outputs.



Someone asks, “Should we keep this AI-generated data?”...
... and the room goes silent.



The documentation for the AI model is stored in five different systems and two email threads.



The organization says it has “AI governance”...
but the documentation starts after deployment.

AI Adoption Is Outpacing Governance

- AI is now embedded in daily workflows and decision systems
- Organizations are moving faster than accountability structures
- Governance failures create compliance, reputational, and operational risk

Evidence:



Workplace AI use has outpaced many organizations' ability to govern it effectively (Gillespie et al., 2025)

The Governance Gap

- Rapid AI deployment

- Weak documentation and auditability
- Increased accountability exposure

What's Missing in Current AI Oversight

RIM Expertise Is Often Absent



Governance teams dominated by IT, legal, privacy, risk



Documentation and lifecycle accountability treated downstream



RIM positioned as compliance backstop,
not governance partner



Cross-functional participation remains uneven
in AI governance programs (IAPP & Credo AI, 2025).

AI governance depends on **traceability and documentation** across the lifecycle (NIST, 2023).



The Shift: From Custodians to Strategists

RIM Must Be Repositioned

Old Role:

- Retention enforcement
- Filing and compliance support
- Post-decision documentation



New Role:

- Governance architect
- AI oversight contributor
- Accountability partner

Operational Strategies



Embed RIM in AI governance committees



Define accountability roles clearly



Align AI oversight with IG frameworks



Require documentation and retention controls at design stage



Treat governance as lifecycle work, not compliance cleanup
